


Auto Typer Tutorial

The Auto Typer Utility assists you to type a Text Sentence with a Keyboard Shortcut. The Latest Version of Auto Typer is always available at the [Auto Typer](#) Home Page along with related information.



The Auto Typer allows you to Store Text Sentence Mapped with a Keyboard Shortcut.


Modes of Auto Typer

There are 2 Modes in which Auto Typer can be used as outlined below:-

1. Copy Paste Mode.
2. Actual Keyboard Typing Mode.

Copy Paste Mode of Auto Typer:

In this Mode the Text Sentence is pasted onto Active Application Window by issuing a Ctrl + V Command.




Effectively if the Ctrl + V Works on your Application Window, then you can use the Auto Typer's Copy Paste Mode to Simply Paste pre-configured Text Sentence onto Active Application Window on the press of the Assigned Keyboard Shortcut.

Note in the above Screenshot that a New Keyboard Shortcut is being added & the Simulate Checkbox is checked to let F6 simulate Ctrl + V Command.

Actual Keyboard Typing Mode

In Actual Typing Mode the Auto Typer simulates typing of the Text Sentence and Special Keys are Available like {ENTER}, {TAB}, etc




This Actual Typing Mode requires your Computer to have .NET Installed. In case you do not have .NET installed, you can download .NET from the button available in the Add Record Screen of [Auto Typer](#)

Actual Typing Mode is comparatively slow as compared to the Copy Paste Mode, however special keys of Keyboard like Enter Key, Tab Key, Function Keys, etc can be embedded into the text sentence as displayed in the example screenshot above.

Verify and Use Auto Typer

Whenever you want the Keyboard Shortcut to type Text onto Active Window, all you need to do is press the desired Keyboard Shortcut.



An easy and quick way to verify the functionality of Auto Typer is to use Notepad or any other Text Editor.

The above Screenshot displays a Notepad Window in which the Keyboard Shortcut F6 (As Added in the Last Example) was pressed.

Once you are satisfied with the Text Typing Functionality, you can proceed ahead and use the Configured Keyboard Shortcut(s) in any other Application Window which lets you Type Text Manually.

The Auto Typer Requires .NET for the Actual Typing Mode and has been Tested on Windows XP, Windows Vista, Windows 7, Windows 8 and Windows 8.1.

On Windows 8 and Windows 8.1, you do not need to worry about .NET as .NET comes pre-installed in these Operating Systems.

Auto Types does not requires Admin Rights to Install it on your Windows Computer.




